

Year 4 – Painting and Printing – Spring 2022

The Year 4 children, in Art and Design lessons, have been learning all about Robert Delaunay and his artwork. The children created their own colour palettes using a range of warm and cool tones. They experimented with printing using four bright coloured paints and 3D objects. They printed onto many different materials including hessian, fabric, card, tissue paper and acetone which all gave different effects. After experimenting with printing, the children also experimented with the layering technique using thickened paint. The children then planned their own Robert Delaunay style artwork, choosing patterns, shapes, colours and techniques.



Printing on hessian makes it look like a tree with vines.



I have made a pattern on the fabric with the blue and yellow paint.
