Lots of you have been doing amazing learning at home! Using your learning packs and learning all sorts of other things to. The staff at Grangetown love to see all learning you're doing.

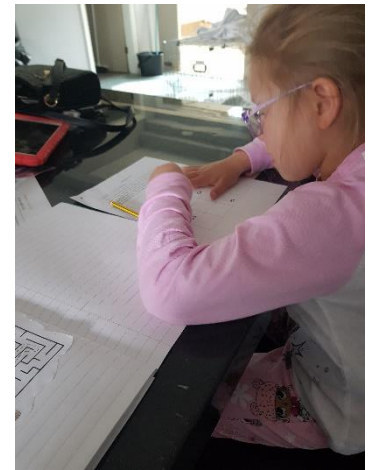
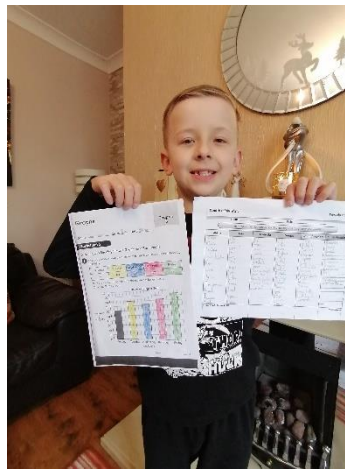
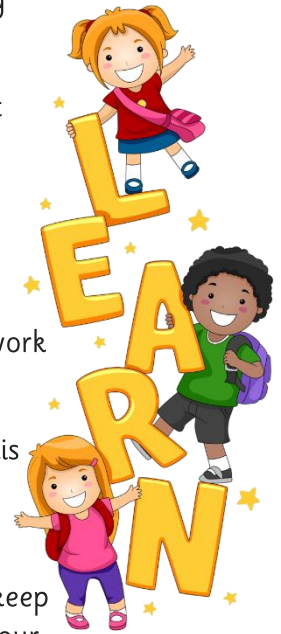
