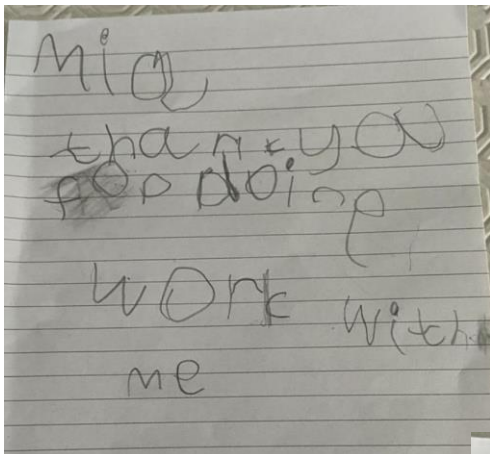

What has been happening?

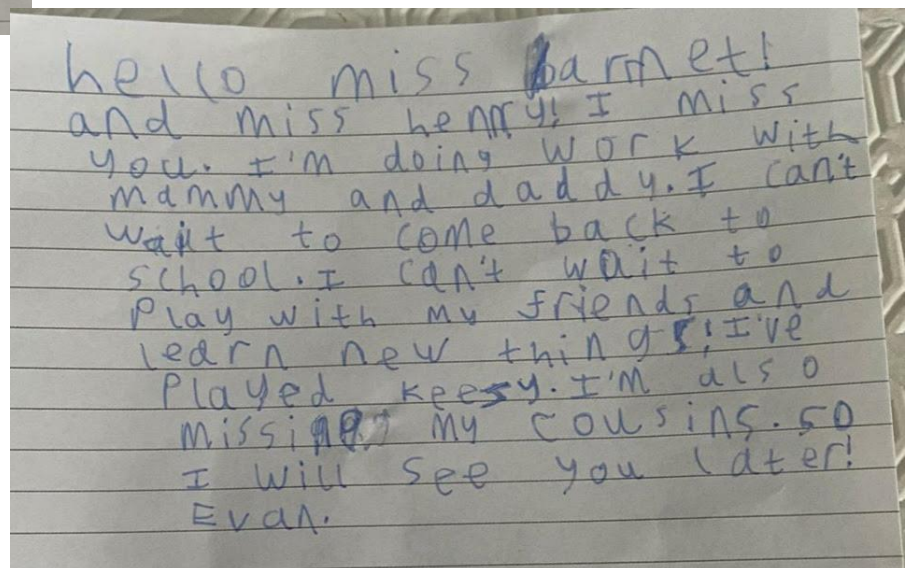
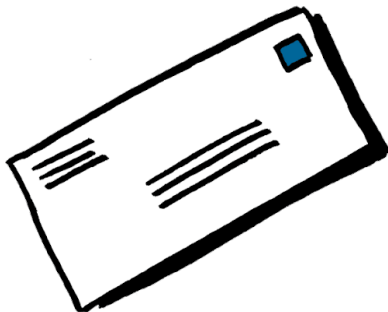
This week we have been sending out your new learning packs. Did you get yours today? It was lovely to see some of you as they were picked up.
