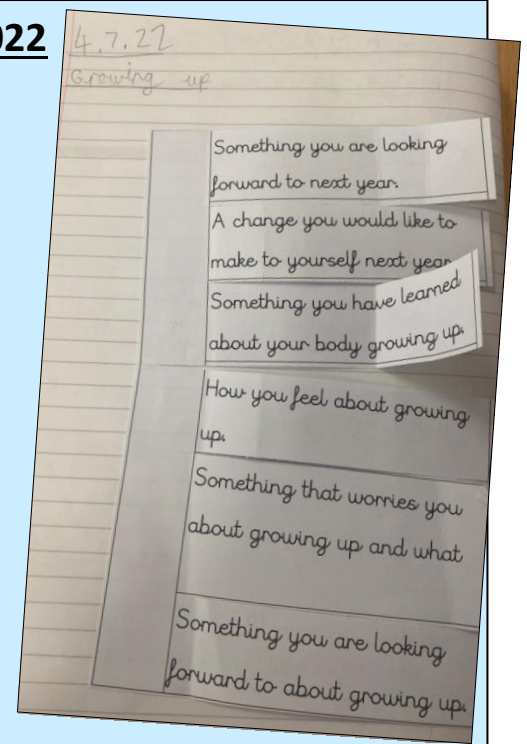


'Changing Me' – PSHE – Jigsaw – KS2 – Summer 2022

Year 3

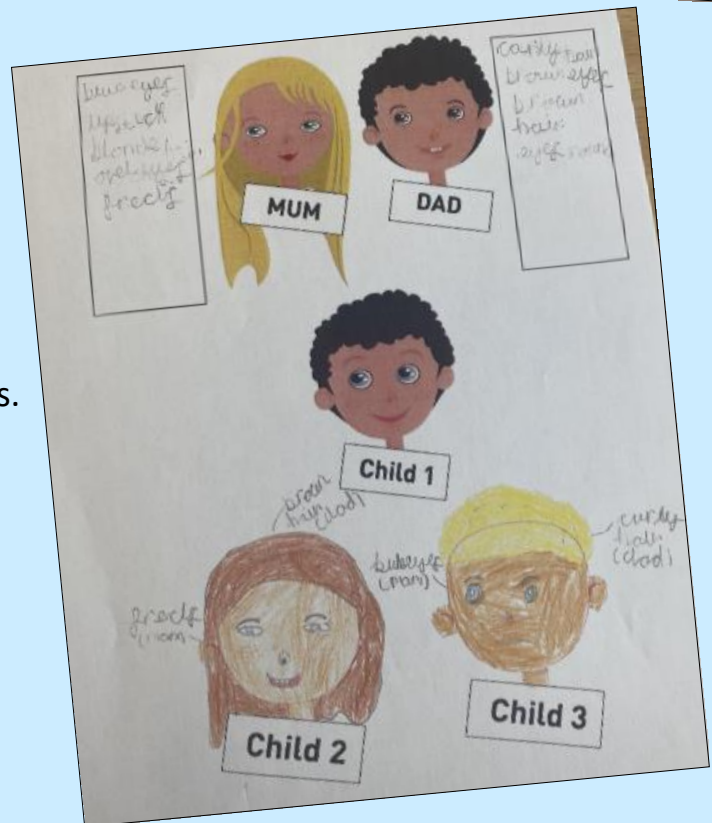
In Year 3 the children have been learning about babies, where they come from and how they are different to children and adults. The children were able to talk about a baby's needs and wants and explain what they need in order to be well looked after.

The children also thought about the changes they might face as they move into Year 4 and discussed how they were feeling about this.



Year 4

In Year 4, the children have been learning about how they inherit features from their parents. The children completed an activity where they had to decide what they think three children would look like based on the appearance of their parents. They discussed why all of the children would not look the same and how we inherit some of our features from our mother and some from our father.



Year 5

Year 5 had a visit from our school nurse in order to talk about puberty. They discussed personal hygiene and how to keep our bodies clean. They also talked about how our bodies change as we get older and how this is different for boys and girls.

Year 6

Year 6 learnt all about the changes that happen to our bodies as we get older. We discussed this in a very mature manner and the children asked many questions to further their understanding. The children wrote down any worries which they had about growing up and we discussed each one. The children offered some great advice to each other.
